



MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

The first service must be undertaken, and the following items addressed, after the caravan has travelled 300km's - 1000km's or within 3 months from date of purchase, whichever comes first.

THE COST OF ALL SERVICING & MAINTENANCE IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PURCHASER

- Check wheel bearings – adjust if necessary
- Check wheel nut tension
- Check tyre pressure and wear pattern
- Visual inspection of suspension & fittings
- Visual inspection of under carriage
- Check brake system
- Check operation of 12V system
- Check operation of appliances

GENERAL ON GOING MAINTENANCE

It is the responsibility of the purchaser to carry out regular maintenance on the caravan for warranty purposes, including the following:

- **Brake and bearing service** – every 12 months or 5000km's
IMPORTANT: PLEASE CAREFULLY READ THE G&S CHASSIS WARRANTY AND SERVICE HANDBOOK FOR CHASSIS AND SUSPENSION MAINTENANCE
- **Seals** - Visual inspection of seals including roof seals and J Mould seals. Expansion and contraction due to varying weather conditions can affect the seals over time. It is important to check these every 12 months and reseal with silicone if required. Please contact your dealer or Van Cruiser Caravans for further advice
IMPORTANT! DO NOT PRESSURE WASH YOUR CARAVAN, THIS CAN DAMAGE PAINT ON PANELS & REMOVE SILICONE AROUND SEALS
- **Suburban Hot Water Service** – replace anode and flush tank of HWS every 12 months to avoid corrosion of tank. Refer to User Manual for instructions
- **Batteries** – to maintain the lifespan of your batteries, we recommend keeping them charged at all times. Running batteries flat can damage cells and shorten the lifespan of your batteries. When the caravan is not in use, turn the caravan off from the main switch and ensure the fridge is also off. Although the caravan is off at the main switch, there is still a trickle feed which can flatten the batteries over time. If the caravan is stored under cover, we recommend plugging it in to 240V once every few weeks to charge the batteries. Please contact your dealer or Van Cruiser Caravans for further advice.
- **Solar panels** – regularly clean the solar panels on the roof for optimum performance
- **Water Tanks** – empty water tanks when caravan is in storage. Change water filter (under sink) every 12 months (if applicable)
